Betting rules

General Rules

The minimum stake is €1. The stake must be a multiple of €0.01. A maximum stake is offered for each selection. Payouts are rounded to €0.01.

Requests for stakes below the minimum or above the maximum amount, as well as for odds higher than those currently offered, are rejected. Requests for odds lower than those currently offered are accepted at the currently offered odds.

Bets placed on an obvious line mistake, or placed after the outcome of the proposition has been determined will be void. Pre-match bets placed after the match has started will also be void.

The dates and times of matches are for informational purposes only. Incorrectly stated dates and/or times are not grounds for cancelling bets. Typographical errors, team name changes, or incorrect league names are not grounds for cancelling bets, provided the context makes it clear which match the bet referred to.

The result of a match is the final decision of the relevant governing authority on the day the match is completed, regardless of any subsequent protests or overturned decisions.

If the venue is changed, all bets on the match will be void unless otherwise stated in the rules of the specific sport.

If a match is not completed, only markets where the outcome has been unequivocally determined at the time of abandonment will be settled. All other bets will be void.

If a match takes place within 12 hours of the scheduled time, bets remain valid. If the match takes place later than 12 hours after the scheduled time, bets will be void.

All settled markets are final after 72 hours, and no claims will be accepted after this period.

Live bets may be subject to a short delay before acceptance.

Football

All match markets are based on the result at the end of the scheduled 90 minutes of play unless otherwise stated. This includes any added injury or stoppage time but does not include extra time, penalty shootouts, or golden goals.

Tennis

The winner of the match is the player who progresses to the next round or wins the tournament. If a player withdraws, the opposing player is deemed the winner. If a player withdraws or is

disqualified, bets on the match outcome will stand if at least one set has been completed; otherwise, such bets will be void.

The next point must be played for all In-Play bets to have action. If either competitor retires, is disqualified or does not continue to play for any reason all bets placed since the last point finished are deemed void.

All bets are valid if the match is completed within seven days of the originally scheduled date.

All bets remain valid regardless of any changes to the venue, court surface, or a switch between indoor and outdoor courts, and vice versa.
